

St. Paul's Preschool & Child Care Covid 19 quarantine & isolation guidelines*

St. Paul's Preschool Center strongly recommends masks but will no longer require them for individuals entering the building.

St. Paul's Preschool reserves the right to determine attendance eligibility based on evaluation of symptoms following assessment by St. Paul's Staff and Administration and may require a doctor's note or negative test results for readmission.

Individuals with a single symptom may be required to remain home until 48 hours symptom free without medication.

If a class is closed due to a positive case within the class, the classroom will be closed for 5 days. Students and staff can return to the classroom on day 6. Children who are 2 years of age and older must wear a mask for an additional 5 days, along with staff, upon their return. Students will NOT be placed in another classroom during this time.

Siblings of students who are exposed may attend if able to wear a mask consistently and correctly.

Siblings of students who test positive for Covid-19 or are presumed positive for Covid-19 will be considered exposed (or a close contact) and should follow the guidelines above.
