In order to provide a safe environment and keep all our staff, families, and students safe and healthy during the COVID-19 pandemic, and in order to ensure that we are able to continue remain open to provide care, we have updated the following travel guidelines .

Get tested upon return and provide proof of negative Covid-19 test results. *	<input checked="" type="checkbox"/>

*if you choose not to test, you must quarantine for 5 days

This does not apply to:

- Individuals traveling to and from Pennsylvania for the purpose of work or within the tri-state area (Pennsylvania, New Jersey, Delaware)

**Up to date means a person has received all recommended doses in their primary series COVID-19 vaccine, and a booster dose when eligible.

The CDC still reminds us that "As a general rule, travel can increase your chance of spreading and getting Covid-19, especially if you are not vaccinated."
